



# Deprecation of Flash Player in Chrome

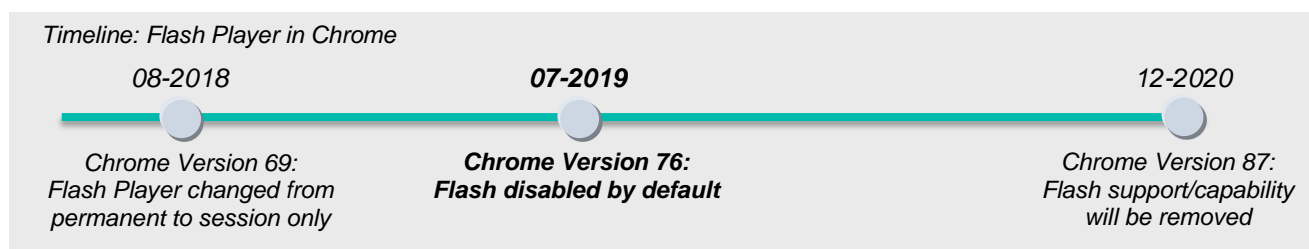
## **Who is concerned?**

All chrome e-file users.

## **Context and timeline**

As part of a global shift from plugins to open web technologies, Adobe will no longer be supporting Flash Player by the end of 2020.

However, before this and to ensure that its users are aware of this change, Google will **disable** Flash Player **by default** in Chrome browsers from **30 July 2019**. This will have implications for e-file, which uses Flash Player, and for those users using Chrome.



It is important to note that Flash Player can still be used between July 2019 and December 2020, but its use, both in general and in the e-file environment, will require specific actions to be taken, either by individual users or by IT administrators.

## **What to do from July 2019**

Depending on your browser version and/or company IT policy, users may encounter difficulties with sites that use Flash after 30 July 2019. For the e-file environment, Fundsquare has identified three options to allow users to continue operating Flash objects:

- Re-enable manually
- A Fundsquare solution (portable Chrome version)
- A client-side solution (manage Flash by policy).
