1 - FATCA Report – New possibilities to populating the TIN field

Dear client,

Following the *International Revenue Service (IRS)* publication in the <u>FATCA FAQs</u> (Populating the TIN Field: Q1, Q1b and Q3) we are happy to share with you the release in production the new possibilities to indicate that a Financial Institution does not have the TIN of an Account holder or its Substantial owner.

Explanation:

Until now, the default TIN used when a Financial Institution did not have a TIN ("#NTA001#" transformed on export by the ACD into "AAAAAAAAA") caused an error on the part of the IRS which was forwarded to the Financial Institution and triggered a 120-day period to provide a correction. In general, this error was reported on the TIN of a PNFE (Passive non-financial entity) which was not a US tax resident and did not have a US TIN and the information was therefore not correctable by the financial institution.

These new possibilities for TINs will allow the IRS to no longer report errors when a Financial Institution has explicitly used these TINs.

2 - FATCA Report – Reporting FI and Reporting person fields

We would also like to communicate a change in the "Name of the reporting financial institute" and "Reporting person" fields. From now on (when applied) the format "Fund/Sub-fund" is replaced by "Fund – Sub-fund". This small change will prevent you from receiving warnings from the ACD stating that the Reporting FI is different from the name declared at the IRS for the GIIN.
